UGA PRESIDENT JERE MOREHEAD SPEAKS

Jere Morehead, UGA's President, addressed a crowded room of Rotarians and quests at Thursday's meeting. With key individuals from the local UGA Griffin Campus on hand, Morehead outlined several advancements that have and are occurring on the campus. A new turfgrass facility to house faculty, staff, and their research laboratories will soon start construction. He iterated that the turfgrass team is internationally renowned and impacts Georgia's economy and environmental health. He noted that groundbreaking had already occurred for the Food Product Innovation and Commercialization Center on the campus and that faculty within the center are already collaborating with industry partners in developing new food products and innovations. He added that the Food Safety Center headed by Mike Doyle is second-to-none in the World. Morehead announced that UGA's Archway Partnership program is coming to Griffin and Spalding County and that he looks for that partnership to address critical employment and economic issues in the community. He also announced that a Board of Visitors would soon be established for the UGA Griffin Campus and will be composed of community leaders and others. Morehead closed by saying that he is very glad to be leading UGA and noted that UGA is actually in every county in the state.

John Quinn, Georgia Rotary Student Program Endowment Trustee, announced Thursday that the GRSP Endowment has established a new level of recognition for continued giving to GRSP. The newly-established level has been named in memory of Griffin Rotary's Jake Cheatham who worked and supported GRSP and its mission of promoting world peace through mutual understanding by offering scholarships to international students for one year of study in Georgia colleges and universities. WHAT IS THE ROTARY FOUNDATION'S "WORLD FUND?"

At the end of every contribution year, each Rotary district's contributions to the Annual Programs Fund are divided into two funds: 50 percent is credited to the World Fund (WF) and 50 percent is credited to the District Designated Fund (DDF). The World Fund is used by The Rotary Foundation to pay for the worldwide programs available to all Rotary districts, regardless of specific contributions.
